As part of our PDHPE teaching and learning program all students aged 8 - 13 years will participate in our annual athletics carnival. Students will have the opportunity to take part in a range of activities such as running, long jump, shot put, high jump and relay races.

Date: Wednesday 25th June 2025

Time: Bus departs school at 9.00am and returns to school at approximately 2.30pm.

** NOTE: If your child is participating in the 800m event you will need to transport them and be at the Mingara Athletic Field by 8.15am for marshalling for an 8.30am start. **

Venue: Mingara Athletics Track

Transport arrangements: Coach transport from / to school (unless participating in the 800m - see above).

Cost: \$15.00 per student (bus and entry fee) or \$12.00 (800m competitors only). Spectators are welcome and there is no fee to attend.

Permission Note/Payment due no later than: Tuesday 17th June 2025

What to bring / Clothing: Students are required to wear full school sports uniform including sport shorts, school sport t-shirt or house coloured t-shirt and a hat. Please apply sunscreen and bring a bottle of water.

Food: Students to bring recess and lunch as normal. TPS canteen will operate the BBQ for lunch, and this will be available to students, parents and carers. The TPS canteen will accept cash and EFTPOS. For your convenience you will also be able to preorder via Flexischools. The Mingara canteen will be operational for drinks, sweets etc.

Zone Athletics Carnvial: Children who qualify for the Tuggerah Lakes Zone Carnival will be notified as soon as possible after our carnival. Notes regarding this will be distributed at school.

Additional:
