Transport arrangements: Students will be walking from Tuggerah Public School to Event Cinemas Westfield in a group and will be supervised by staff.

What to bring / Clothing:

Students are required to wear full school uniform. Please bring a hat and sunscreen should be applied in the morning at home.

Food: A bottle of water will be provided by the school for each child. No food allowed in cinemas.

Additional:
