Years 3-6 Starr's Planetarium Incursion

This semester Stage 2 and Stage 3 are learning all about Earth and Space in Science. Starr's Planetarium offer the largest and most diverse choice of digital planetarium (full dome) shows in Australia, and their presenter-led astronomy shows are delivered by engaging and experienced science communicators. The content aligns closely with the current NSW Science K-10 syllabus.

We are committed to providing quality educational opportunities for our Stage 2 and Stage 3 classes, with Starr's Planetarium taking students on an interactive space adventure through the solar system and onwards to the galaxy and then back down to Earth. The visiting presenter will challenge the students' ability to reason and stimulate their intellectual curiosity and imagination, as well as promoting their analytical and divergent thinking.

Sessions run for 40-60 minutes and each class will be assigned a time across the 2 days.
