Please note: Doors will not open to parents until 8.00pm.

Venue: The Entrance Leagues Club, Bateau Bay

Transport arrangements: Own arrangements via private transport. If you are unable to transport your own child please try to arrange car-pooling with your child's friends who may be attending.

Cost: \$26.00 per student. The cost of the evening has been subsidised thanks to Tuggerah Public School and the fundraising efforts of Year 6 students. The cost of \$26.00 covers dinner, cake, decorations and room hire. The School Photographer has generously donated yearbooks for all students.
