Transport arrangements: Meet at Tuggerah train station Kiss and Ride area of the commuter car park, Bryant Drive, at 6.00am. Train will depart at 6.20am, and arrive back at Tuggerah train station at 4.50pm. Teacher will update parents if there are any delays.

Cost: Your child must have a valid Child/Youth Opal card with \$12.00 credit for rail fares. The cost of the conference is being covered by Tuggerah Public School.

Clothing / What to bring: Full school uniform including hat is to be worn. Please bring a pen for taking notes. On the day of the event, the Halogen Pin will be available to purchase for \$5.

Food: Students to bring morning tea, lunch and water.

Additional:
