Dear Parents & Carers,

I would like to take this opportunity to thank families for their commitment to Learning from Home this week.

We will participate in learning in different ways over the coming weeks and there is no 'right' way to engage in Learning at Home. We understand that at times this can be difficult. We encourage you to be kind to yourselves and just do what you can, the best way you can. Below is a table with recommendations of workload.

K- 2	2 ½ hours a day	Plus some physical activity
3 – 6	3 hours per day	

Our school will remain open for students and families who need it, although parents are encouraged to keep their children home if they can, to ensure family's and school staff's safety. There will be minimal supervision and our school will provide one unit of work for students, whether they are learning at home or at school. If your arrangements fluctuate between school and home, please ensure your child brings their Learning from Home packs with them each time they attend school.

## Learning from Home - Monday 19 July - Friday 30 July (Weeks 2 & 3)

Due to the restrictions outlined by the Premier on Wednesday 14 July, Tuggerah PS will continue to provide Learning Plans so students can engage in Learning from Home. Teachers have been busily writing and organising 2 week plans for their classes.

On Monday 19 July all students will be provided with their books, including textbooks and Learning from Home Packs that they will need to complete their Learning from Home over the next 2 weeks. We will continue to follow the normal drive through routine. (Please remain in your car and a staff member will come to you.)

Each student's books will be available for pick up at the following times:

**Monday 19 July** Years 3 – 6 between 9:15 – 10:15 (You are able to pick up younger sibling's books at this time)

## Kindergarten – Year 2 between 11:30 and 12:30

Please note: Siblings books will go home with the eldest student.

If your child attends school because you are an essential worker and **they are unwell** we will ask for them to be picked up from school. They are not able to return to school until they have a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free **or** they have isolated for 10 days, when there is no medical certificate available.

Thank you to all Tuggerah Public School staff for working together as a team to ensure all students have access to learning materials digitally and on paper.
